Correction: Cognitive Susceptibility to Smoking: Two Paths to Experimenting among Mexican Origin Youth

In this article (1), which was published in the December 2009 issue of *Cancer Epidemiology, Biomarkers & Prevention*, 70 participants who were born in the US were miscoded as being born in Mexico. The error does not significantly change the results in Table 2 (original *P*-value = 0.582) and hence does not impact the interpretation or the conclusions drawn.
