Cancer Epidemiology, Biomarkers & Prevention publishes original research on cancer causation and prevention in humans, linking three previously unintegrated disciplines: epidemiology, biomarkers, and prevention. Topics include descriptive, analytical, biochemical, and molecular epidemiology; the use of biomarkers to study the neoplastic and preneoplastic processes in humans; chemoprevention and other types of prevention trials; and the role of behavioral factors in cancer etiology and prevention. Manuscripts that address individual subjects in any of the three disciplines are welcome as well as manuscripts with an interdisciplinary approach. All submissions undergo peer review. Faculty Position in Cancer Epidemiology

The Division of Public Health Sciences of the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center invites applications for an epidemiologist faculty position at the assistant member level (equivalent of assistant professor at a university). The candidate should have a PhD in Epidemiology or an MD plus master's level training in epidemiology, or equivalent degree(s). The candidate should have interest and at least 2 years experience in studies of the etiology and outcome of breast cancer. Priority will be given to applicants who have previously conducted population-based interdisciplinary investigations in collaboration with clinical- and laboratory-based scientists—aimed at elucidating environmental, genetic, and molecular factors of etiologic and prognostic significance. Preference will also be given to individuals who have conducted large-scale family studies to investigate gene-environment interactions. Resources available include laboratory facilities and existing population-based studies that involved collection of biological samples.

The Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center is a comprehensive cancer center with large and active research programs in epidemiology, cancer prevention and biostatistics. A joint appointment in the University of Washington School of Public Health and Community Medicine's Epidemiology Department as a Research Assistant Professor is possible, depending on interests and qualifications. This would involve advising individual students on thesis or dissertation research.
